Hacker Jeopardy

A high-energy trivia showdown blending technical knowledge, pop culture, and ROOTCON lore. Fast, fun, and unpredictable.

Hacker Karaoke

Where hackers trade keyboards for microphones. No skill required—just the courage to take the stage and have fun.

ROOTCON Wi-Finders

A wireless exploration challenge focused on discovery, signals, and the unseen networks around the venue.
